Take advantage of this new offer and try out a unique way of getting around the streets of Prague. Three different routes allow you to get around the city comfortably with an unlimited number of transfers for a whole 24 or 48 hours! A steward is available in every bus for the whole ride. All buses are equipped with headphones playing audio recordings about Prague in 22 different languages.

In addition, by buying a ticket you save 440 CZK for an hour-long boat trip and free entrance to a unique exposition of a railway model of the Czech Republic and Prague!

Entrance to the Railroad Kingdom is not limited by the validity of the ticket and can be used at any time.

Tickets are available for 24 or 48 hours. This year there is the additional possibility of buying just a one-time headset around Prague with headphones in 22 languages.

## Down Town

The route marked in green is our main route and also the most comprehensive, with something to satisfy everyone. It will take you in comfort to the most important Prague sights, for example the Prague Castle, the Old Town Square and Wenceslas Square. Stop 14 on this route is also a transfer stop for the boat trip included in the price of the ticket. In no event you should let this unique experience pass you by, as from the deck of the boat you will experience Prague from a whole new perspective. In the vicinity of all 15 stops you will find the most beautiful spots in our capital, also known as Prague of the Hundred Spires in the heart of Europe.

## Brewery

The yellow B line, bearing the title Brewery, is not only for beer-lovers, though a visit to the Staropramen Brewery Museum is decidedly worth it, but also for model train enthusiasts. The Railroad Kingdom at stop 4 is a true rarity that will enthral children and adults alike. By the A/B transfer station you can visit the funicular up Petřín hill, the relaxing Kampa Park, the gallery Sovovy mlýny, as well as the island Střeškovský ostrov with a beautiful view of the Charles Bridge.

## Vyšehrad

The red C line is, at first glance, a relatively uninteresting tour, but looks are deceiving! Get off at stop 2 and discover Vyšehrad Castle hidden behind the ramparts and intertwined with many national legends. The dark silhouette of the tower poking up from the cliff over the river inherently belongs to the Prague landscape. Also make a stop under TV Tower where you discover a newly opened restaurant on the top with a really beautiful view of all of Prague. Few minutes walking from TV tower there is Vitkov - and don't be afraid of the hill before you. At the top you are awaited not only by a proud statue of the Hussite leader Jan Žižka of Trocnov, which is among the largest equestrian statues in the world, but also a national memorial built to honour the memory of the Czech legionnaires and the Czech resistance during World War I, and last but not least a marvellous view of all of Prague.



A ticket at CZK 300 for an adult, or CZK 200 for a child, will allow you to enjoy a tour of whatever length you like, but with only a single boarding of the bus at any stop along the route of the green line - A - Downtown. The hour-long boat tour is not included in the price of this one-time tour.
